


## SUCCESSFUL PARENTAL RESPONSES

- Don't criticize, condemn or complain.
- Be honest and sincerely appreciative.
- Be a good listener.
- Bring out in them eagerness and wanting.

- Use encouragement: Make the fault seem easy to correct.
- If you are wrong, admit it quickly and say you are sorry.
